To establish a Skill Hub and provide skill-based training for deployment of human resource and to develop an infrastructure for the creation and dissemination of knowledge.	<p>The proposal for the creation of the Skill Hub in the old campus of Narajole Raj College under the supervision of the IQAC has been duly approved by the Governing Body and the budget requirements have also been sanctioned. The Skill Hub training will be offered to both students of the college as well as to stakeholders from Boramara, the village adopted by the college. The pilot survey among students and stakeholders revealed that there is a demand for Training in Tailoring and Beautician & Make-Up Training Course. The appointment of professional trainers and the registration of students for training in the Skill Hub initiative have been successfully concluded in November 2022. The inauguration of the Skill Hub is scheduled in January 2023.</p> <p>The Skill Hub has an entrepreneurial aspect and can provide flexible economic solutions through interaction with industry and corporate establishments.</p>	Complied

The Archive Committee has also been established on 30.11.2022 with External Experts and Internal Members of the college. The meeting of the Archive Committee for the implementation of the project proposal is due in December 2022. To facilitate training in historical research methodology a Certificate Course in Archival Research to be offered by the Dept. of History within the premise of an existing historical site will be introduced in 2023 as per approval of the Governing Body of the college.
