All Feedback was analysed with the help of Google Analyser.

STUDENT:

The Student Feedback was conducted in two phases: one for the outgoing students of UG 6th Semester and PG 4th Semester in August 2022 and the other for the current students of UG 3rd & 5th Semesters in November 2022. In the first phase there were 338 respondents and in the second phase the number of respondents was 327. Most of the students are quite satisfied with the teaching-learning process. There is a uniform demand to improve library facilities and to increase the number and availability of relevant books in the reading & lending sections.

ALUMNI:

99 members of the registered Alumni Association of Narajole Raj College participated in the Alumni Feedback procedure. Most of the respondents expressed satisfaction regarding the performance of the faculty, the infrastructural aspects and the quality of governance in the college. There is a consensus regarding the need to improve library, laboratory, hostel and canteen facilities.

FACULTY:

63 faculty members participated in the Faculty Feedback conducted for the session 2021-22. The faculty expressed complete satisfaction with the performance of the Academic Committee and the curriculum implantation process. Regarding library utilization and research support from the institution their responses have been positive. The examination and evaluation system has been rated excellent by the faculty. The

faculty has shared recommendations on the improvement of ICT facilities in the college and have also emphasized infrastructural development.

PARENTS:

307 responses were received from the Parent Feedback exercise. Parents have shared suggestions on the reformation of the fee structure and on the improvement of canteen facilities. They have expressed satisfaction with the quality of teaching in the college and have responded moderately to the availability of drinking water and sanitation facilities in the college.

To update teaching-learning processes, every classroom should have a laptop and projector with high-speed Wi-Fi connection. More smart classrooms are needed for smooth teaching and learning. It would be very helpful if there was a well-equipped central laboratory for research. Currently, faculty members are overburdened with official work. It is possible to drive this official work pressure toward research. Teachers' Canteen should be improved. In addition to the written examination, a blended mode of evaluation needs to be implemented (oral/PPT presentation, group discussion, creative writing, etc.). Courses on life skills and employability skills are required. It is necessary to improve the integration of ICT into curriculum delivery. A student-centered approach to teaching and learning is needed, as well as a motivation to pursue research.
