Description: On 13th April 2023, the Equal Opportunity Cell under the guidance of the IQAC, Narajole Raj College, observed the 132nd Birth Anniversary of Dr. B. R. Ambedkar and paid homage to his visions and ideals. Pragna Paramita Mondal, IQAC Coordinator and Convener of Equal Opportunity Cell, welcomed the guests and spoke about Dr. Ambedkar's relentless efforts in creating the foundations of social justice and egalitarianism in India in her introductory remarks. The programme was presided by our Vice Principal, Dr. Ranajit Kumar Khalua, who emphasized the contribution of Dr. Ambedkar as a maker of Indian constitution and society in his address. Dr. Mangal Kumar Nayak, Assistant Professor & HOD, Dept. of History of Narajole Raj College, presented an invited lecture on "Ambedkar's Legacy: The Caste Movement in India after 1956" with analytical references on the caste question and the situation of caste politics in contemporary India. An important segment of the programme was the "My India Quiz Competition" conducted by Dr. Uttam Kumar Singha, CTO, NCC of Narajole Raj College. The competition comprised of four rounds on Dr. B. R. Ambedkar's life and work, Indian Culture and Society, Indian Defence and Indian Polity and Politics. Six teams from different academic departments participated in the competition and won prizes. The programme also witnessed the participation of students, teachers of Singaghai Primary School where the college conducts its outreach activities. The students of the school performed the welcome song with cadence and melody and also recited poetry. Head Teacher, Mr. Sandipan Maity, expressed his thoughts in joining the observance and gave away certificates to the winners.







Summary Report on Seminar


Rationale of the seminar

Themes addressed	1. Sri Suman Biswas introduced the
	students to the importance of the
	Indian Constitution and
	presented an inspiring narrative
	of how the Constitution was
	drafted and what idealism it

represents. He gave an interesting account of the different actors involved in the framing of the Indian Constitution and highlighted the contributions of Dr. B. R. Ambedkar in envisioning the core values of the Constitution. He also explained the significance of national symbols such as the Indian flag or the Ashok Stambha and mentioned the calligraphers and artists who were engaged in the act of writing the world's longest (written) constitution.



2. Dr. Prithwish Kumar Hait presented a Special Lecture and PPT on "Reservation: An Imperative to Social Justice" to resonate the mandate of the Equal Opportunity Cell. He spoke at length on "cancel culture" and on why affirmative action can address the social, economic and cultural disparities that exist across caste groups and across classes in Indian society. He used data evidences in the areas of education, employment, health, nutritional outcomes and statistics on childbirth, maternal mortality and institutional deliveries to show how unequal access and opportunities are

	ingrained into the fabric of Indian society.
Outcome of the seminar	The discussion illuminated the audience members on important facts regarding the socio-economic structures of Indian society and emphasized the idea of inclusive growth. It exposed the youth to profound ideas on the vision of our Counstitution and informed them about our rich cultural heritage. It

	also inspired them to seek sustainable solutions to the problems that wreck our society.
Feedback	Almost 300 students and 50 faculty members turned up for the seminar. The speakers interacted with the students and our first esteemed speaker engaged the student participants with a brief Constitution Quiz in the course of his presentation.
