Introduction : Department of Political Science has resolved in its Departmental meeting dated 10th May 2022 (Agenda No 3.) to offer a Value Added Course entitled “Human Rights Education” for the students of all Departments of Humanities and Science. The Department of Political Science conducted Foundation Course in Human Rights Education (UGC Approved) from 2011 to 2016 and independently in 2016 and 2017. This Value Added Course on Human Rights Education is deemed to be an extension as well as continuation of the previously conducted Foundation Course in Human Rights Education.

Objectives : We, the people of India live in a country which is unique in many senses. India – the largest democracy in the world, a multicultural, developing country. In such a country awareness and proper implementation of human rights is always of the utmost importance. Because any violation of human rights is not mere violation of human rights but it also threatens the noble ideas of democracy, tolerance and sustainable development. The objective of this course is to make our students aware of human rights so that they can play active and positive role to promote and exercise human rights in their lives and set instance in the society. We do believe knowledge of human rights is the best defence against their violation.

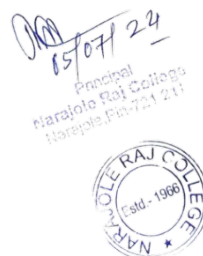

Total no of participant is around sixty.

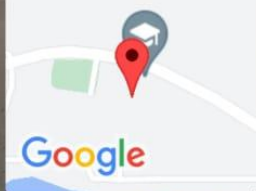
Programme Outcome:
