All concerned are requested to note that as per the instruction issued by the Principal Secretary, Department of Higher Education, Govt. of West Bengal vide its Order No. 89-Edn(CS)/10M-32/2021 dated 31.01.2022 and as per advisory given by Inspector of Colleges, Vidyasagar University the College will re-open for holding offline classes / classes in on campus physical mode on an from 3rd of February, 2022 (Thursday). In this respect following points are to be noted and strictly adhered to by all concerned especially by the students of the College who will be attending the College for offline classes and other activities:

- (a) Offline classes will be held for different semesters as per schedule and routine to be circulated separately for different semesters taking into consideration the academic calendar circulated by the University and the examination schedule for different semesters. Routine for the time being will be circulated by concerned academic departments.
- (b) All the *COVID protocols and safety norms* as mentioned in the Government Order No. 1058-Edn (CS)/10M-32/2021 dated 28.10.2021 are to be followed in their letter and spirit. These are required for physical safety and well-being of all concerned. Students are asked to go through the point 13.3 of that Government Order in details and follow these sincerely. To be more specific, policy of 'No Mask – No Class', 'No Crowding – Maintain Social Distance in and around the College Campus', 'Don't stay inside the premises when classes are over' and the like will be followed rigorously;
- (c) Only those Students who are *vaccinated* will be allowed for offline on campus classes. They are to carry their Vaccination Certificate to be produced at the main entrance at the time of their entry or at any time on demand by any authority of the College. if any student is not yet vaccinated then he/she must communicate it to the College Authority;
- (d) Students who will come to the College are asked to *come to the College 30 minutes* before the scheduled start of their classes on a given day as per the routine circulated by concerned academic department. They are to *pass through the 'Thermal Screening' and 'Sanitisation Process'* at the main entrance of the College;
- (e) Students are advised to carry their own items of food and drinking water for better health management during this COVID period. Canteen facility may be available with 75% of its capacity;
- (f) Activities like study tours, cultural programmes/competition in offline mode, gathering inside the College premises for reasons other than those connected with holding of offline classes and the like are suspended till further order;

- (g) Library reading room facilities will not be available right now. However, facilities of lending and borrowing of books will be available as per the procedure to be made known in due course by the Central Library of the College;
- (h) All concerned are asked/requested to follow the College website and relevant WhatsApp group regularly for further updates.
